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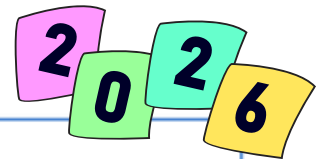

COUNTABLE NOUS

- Nouns you **can count**
- You can use a / an in front of countable nouns.
- Nouns that have a plural form.

UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

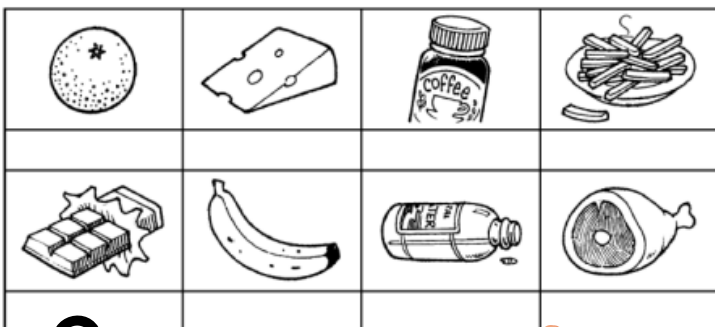
- Nouns you **can't count**
- Nouns that normally don't have a plural form



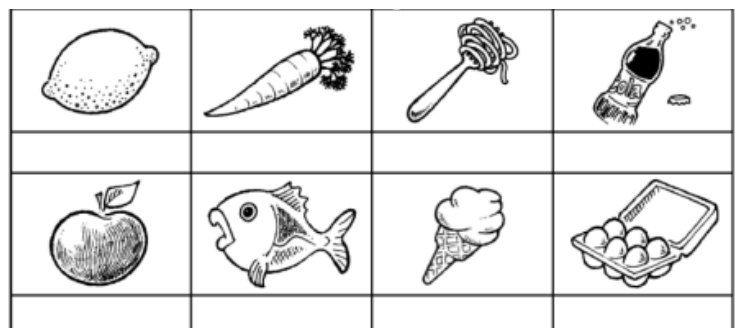
- We can make uncountable nouns countable to express quantity. We add a unit or a quantity with "OF"

e.g. a **bar of** chocolate

- negative **ANY** There isn't **any** cheese in the fridge.

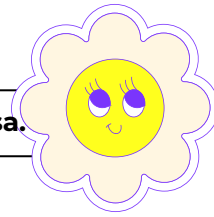

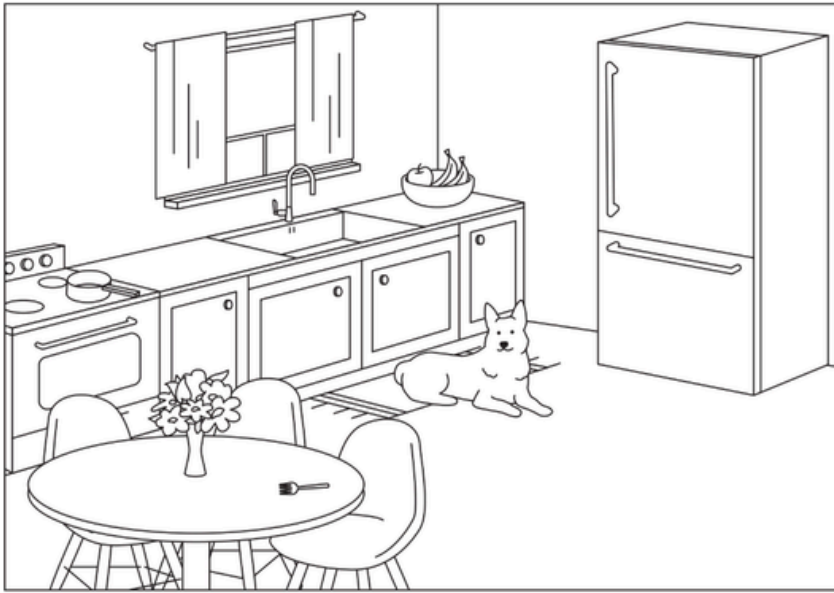
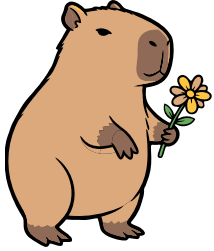
