SPORTS PHOTOGRAPHY – a dream job?

A lot of teenagers want to become professional athletes, but only a few reach the top. Luckily, there's another way to work in sports and get close to the action, even if you aren't a great athlete: you can become a sports photographer.

The photographer is an essential part of the sports media. They are responsible for capturing high-speed action, emotion, and key moments during a game. A photographer also has to select and edit the best images quickly so newspapers and websites can publish them immediately.
